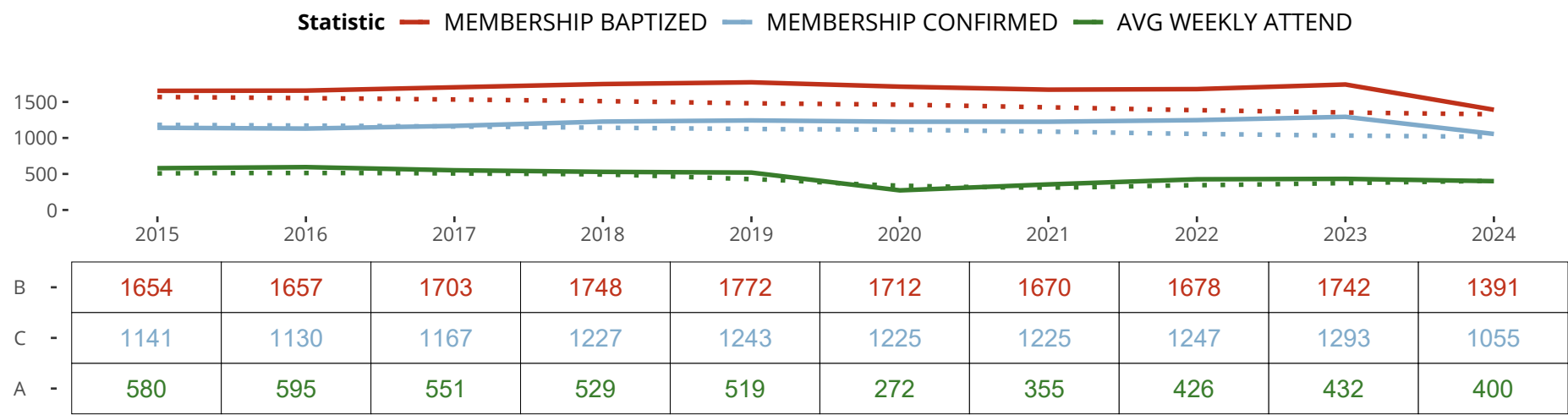
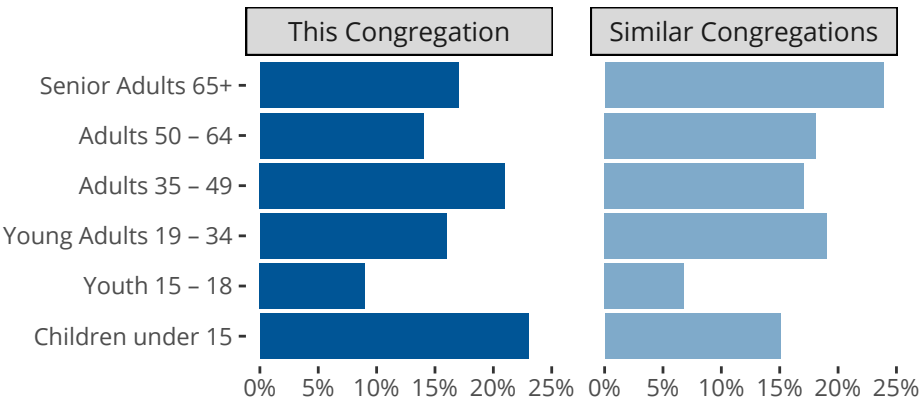


Ten Year Trends for the Congregation in Membership and Attendance

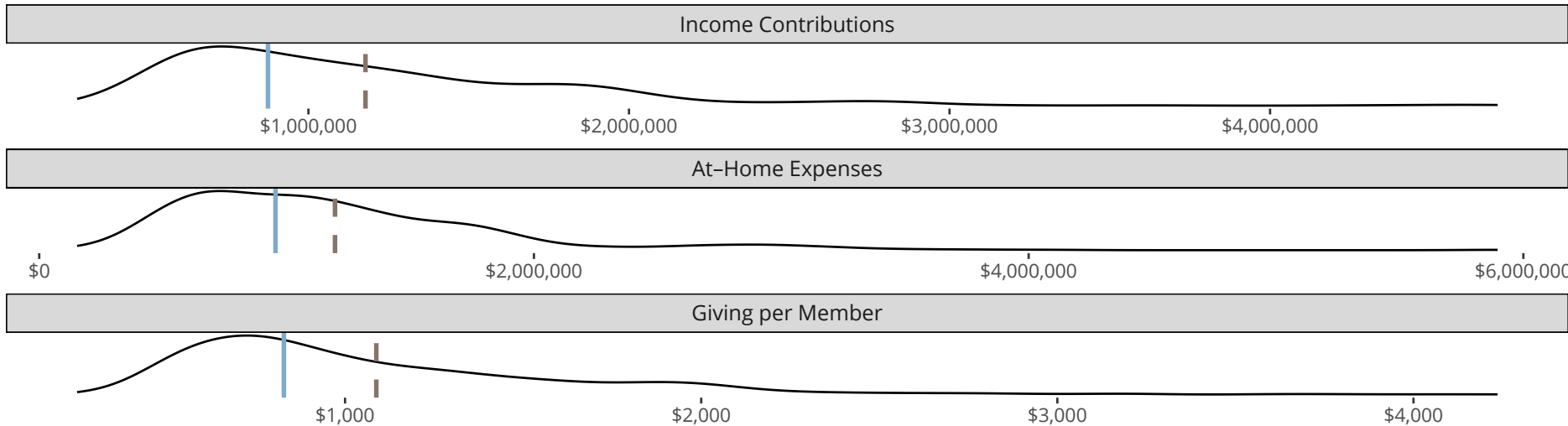
